Scope and Contents

Together with his brothers Pierre and Jean Lafitte, Dominique You acquired wealth and a certain reputation through privateering before the Lafitte-You manpower and gun powder saved the day for the Americans at the Battle of New Orleans (1815 Jan. 8). Following that effort, You and his brothers returned to privateering. You retired first and returned to New Orleans, where he died in 1830.

The collections consists of official papers on the voyages of the French corsair "Le Pandoure", and the goods and ships taken by her captain, Dominique You. The papers include a description of the near destruction of the ship and serious injury to Captain You from a storm on the Mississippi River below New Orleans (1812 Aug. 19). Also included in the collection are receipts of amounts paid by Benetaud against You's debts, and on You's payment to Benetaud.
